Giving Ask from Athletic Participants (email blast and draft)

- Ask to sign up for online giving at a min. of \$2/week (\$2, 5, 10, 25 will be options)
- Focus on those not giving, not catholic but enjoy the facilities, sports, and community of SFA
- Money will go to the A/C in the gym, floor painting of the gym, concession stand renovation, fields, all athletic facilities.
