

## COVID19 Update

On Monday July 27th, St. Louis County released a new set of COVID guidelines, which will become effective at 5 p.m. on Friday, July 31. Among these guidelines, the County has reduced from 50 percent down to 25 percent capacity our church occupancy. This is based on the authorized fire or building code occupancy.

- This means that our church can accommodate 150 people per Mass.
- Attendance will be on a first come, first seated basis.
- Please be aware that we do have the celebration of First Communion over the next couple of weekends and this may mean we will reach our capacity sooner than previous weekends. This weekend, August 1 & 2 there will be First Communions celebrated at 4 p.m. on Saturday and 9 a.m. on Sunday. We encourage you to attend the 7 a.m. or 11 a.m. if you plan to attend in person.
- Please remember that while in church you must still wear a mask or face covering and maintain appropriate social distancing.
