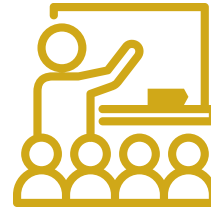


Option 1: SFA @ SFA

Many parents and students have indicated a desire to be back at school. We have a plan to provide safe learning within our large building five days a week, following Archdiocesan and County guidelines.



Attendance, Health and Hygiene

- Parents will complete a form (possibly through an app) regarding the health of their child prior to the child entering school.
- Random temperature checks will be conducted throughout the day.
- No parents or visitors will enter school when children present unless there are special circumstances approved by the principal.
- Frequent hand washing and sanitizing will take place in classrooms and individually throughout the day.
- Groups will be spaced out and accounted for to reduce density and provide easy contact tracing.

Masks, Face Coverings, and Shields

- Students of all ages will wear masks on lanyards, gaiters, or shields to enter and exit school, in hallways, and when social distancing is not possible.
- Staff will wear masks or shields.
- Students in grades 4-8 will wear masks, gaiters, or shields in hallways, bathrooms, and in classroom with certain activities.
- Masks or shields will not be mandated when students are working at a distance, eating lunch, during PE, or at recess but may be worn if desired.
- Clear acrylic or Plexiglas shields are being used for lunch tables, desks, classroom tables and other areas for safety and to maintain the ability to work collaboratively and gather socially in safe ways.



Daily Routines

- Students will bring a labeled water bottle to school each day.
- Students will attend Mass in smaller groups or virtually.
- Lunch for K-8 will be in the gym/cafe with reduced numbers at a time, spread out with acrylic partitions on tables. Lunch may be brought from home or purchased. Purchased lunch items will be pre-trayed or pre-packaged for safety. Extra sanitizing procedures, designated seating areas.
- Recess and outdoor learning will take place with designated areas to keep cohorts of students together to lessen exposure. Playground equipment will be sanitized daily. Hands will be cleaned and sanitized before and after use.
- Specialty classes will either take place in homerooms, or classrooms will be sanitized between groups.
