Basketball-Dave Schulte

- Report given by Frank

- Season is complete
  - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade – Stotts continues to pursue playoff victories
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Grade – Lumsden lost in the second game
- No uniform return dates scheduled yet
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Day
  - Went well this year
  - 4 teams total and everyone was appreciative
  - Last game ended up being a forfeit

#### Capital Improvements/Facilities Committee

- Gym Painting
  - Recommendation submitted
  - Will not take place until after school gets out
- Concession Building Roof is in Disrepair
  - Bids are being pursued
  - Have a contractor interested in exchange for advertising space
- Advertising
  - 4 companies have committed to paying for space
  - Overview
    - 3x6 banners at Bussen and SFA Ball Fields
      - \$1000 initial and \$500 annual renewal
    - 12x18 yard sale size in the Parish Center
      - Includes exposure to parish events

#### Baseball/Softball – Mike Rekart

- Meeting held with coaches at the County level and turnout was extremely poor
- April 11<sup>th</sup> is the start of the season – SFA fields start on April 12<sup>th</sup>
- No dates yet for uniforms
- Schedules just now came, so we are still working on getting shifts added to the volunteer site
- 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade not being released until Mid-April

#### Intramural Baseball/Softball- Rob Witzel

- We had to combine one of our teams because of numbers
- Schedules were just received and will be distributed soon
